

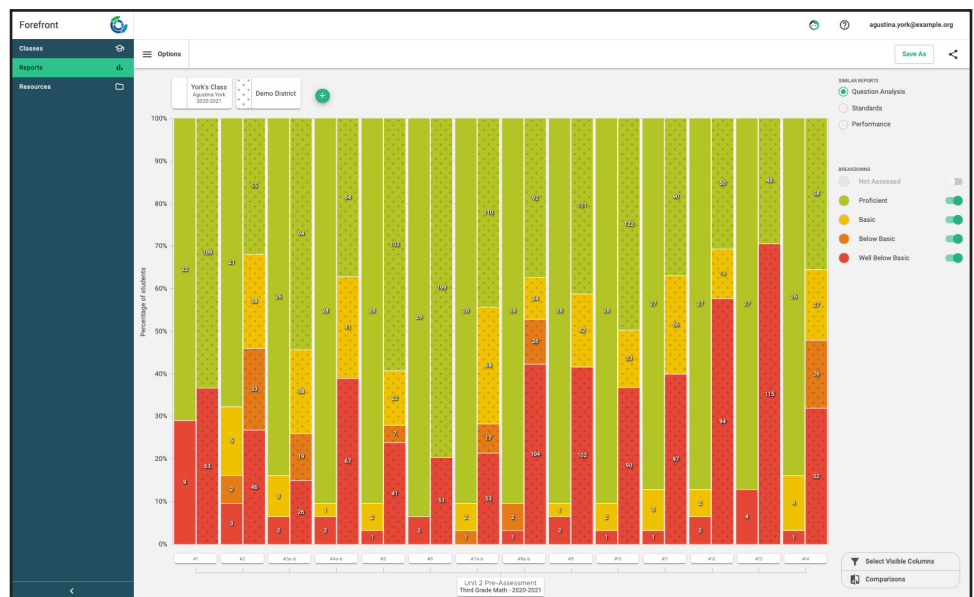
Data Discussion Protocols: *It's All About the Teaching!*

This protocol is designed to support reflection on instruction, what is working, and what needs to be modified. This protocol is best used in regular cycles so that new strategies can be implemented and tested for effectiveness.

This protocol uses the Single Assessment Report, viewing the Question Analysis View.

Use the Performance View in the Single Assessment Report.

1. Choose an Item Analysis report.
2. If you have more than one year's data, consider using the Item Analysis Comparison report to compare results across more than one year. Use "Comparisons" in the lower right corner.
3. Also consider this year's results relative to larger cohorts.
4. Ask:
 - Where was the class most successful?
 - To what do you attribute that success?
 - Which question(s) caused the most difficulty for your students?
 - Consider the questions themselves and some student work samples that you have. How do you see the evidence of your instruction in the student results?
 - What implications does this have for your work in the next unit(s)?
