Student Name	Puts student first and last name on the document.	Alita Clark
Student ID	Puts the student ID type you identify into the document. (Useful for ingesting documents into certain communications systems.)	12345678
Standard Proficiency	Puts the text of the standard proficiency in the document. This is the data for a standard you would see on the student wheel.	Meeting
Assessment Total Score	Number of points the student earned added.	36
Overall Assessment Proficiency	Puts the text of the overall proficiency <b>on a specific assessment</b> in the document.	Meeting
Overall Assessment Proficiency (Background Color)	Puts the text <b>and a background color</b> of the overall proficiency <b>on a specific assessment</b> in the document.	Meeting
Assessment Standard Proficiency (Background Color)	Puts the text <b>and a background color</b> of the <b>standards proficiency on a specific assessment</b> in the document.	Meeting
